

Harriet Babcock Preserve

Mansfield, CT

The Babcock Preserve is a 10-acre parcel that was left to the Trust in 1985 as a bequest of Harriet Babcock. It runs from Browns Road on the south to the town's Schoolhouse Brook Park on the north.

It is bisected west to east by Chapin Brook, a seasonal stream. The vegetation is a young oak-hickory forest with a small red maple swamp along the brook.

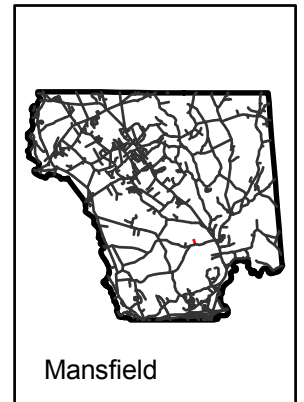
