

Allanach-Wolf Woodlands Windham. CT

Allanach-Wolf Woodland is a 122-acre preserve, 102 acres of which were left to the Trust by Ada Wolf in 2007.

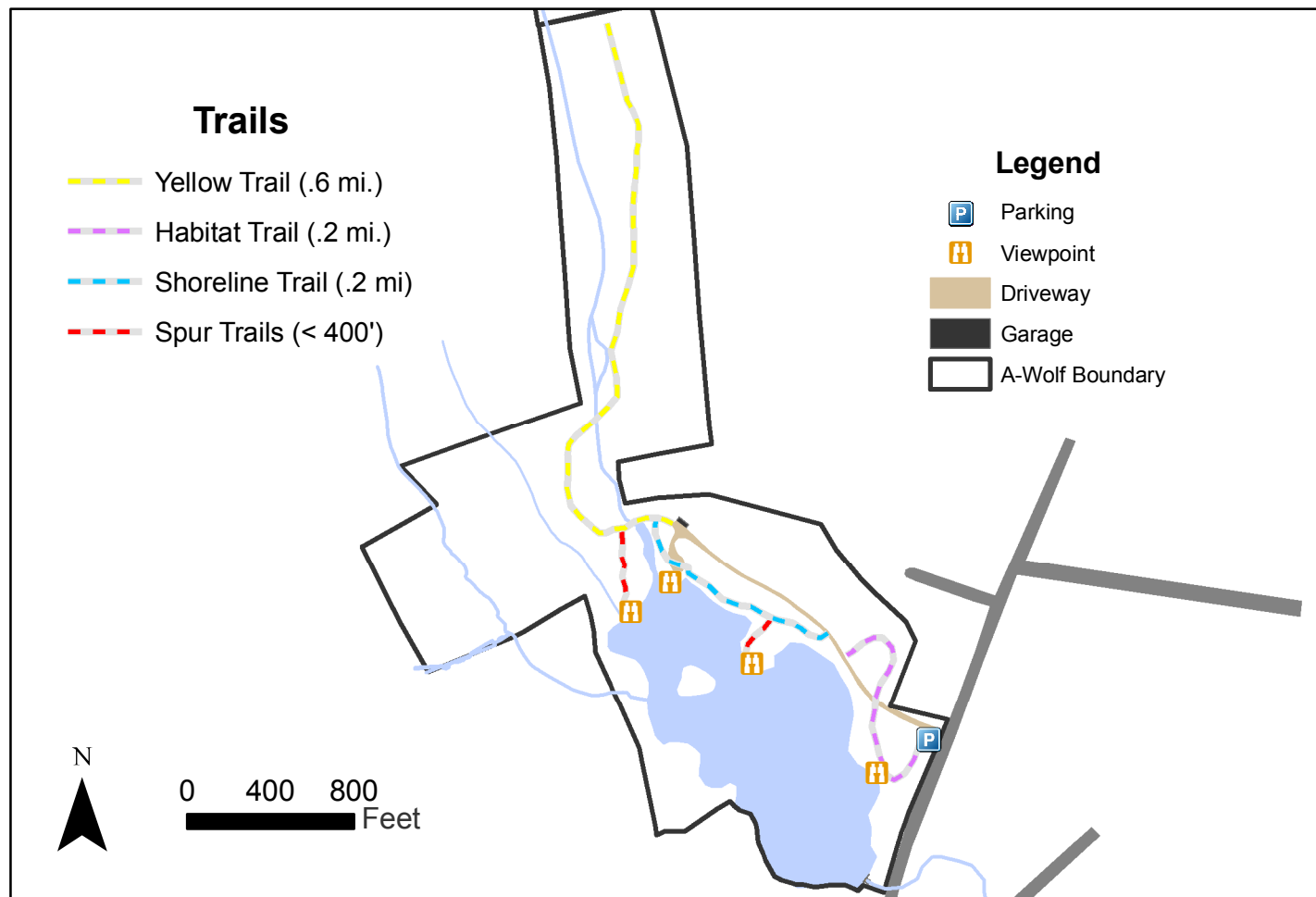
The centerpiece of the preserve is a shallow 23-acre pond known as Lake Marie. It is fed by 3 streams that enter at the north end. The main trail parallels the largest stream, Ballamahack Brook.

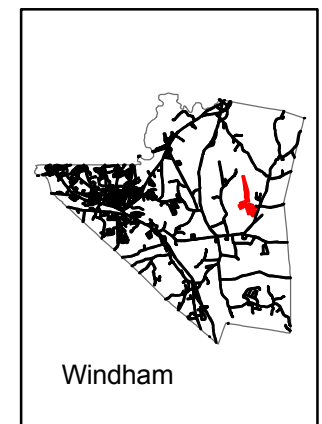
