

H.E. Preston Sanctuary

Hampton, CT

The H.E. Preston Nature Sanctuary is a 107-acre preserve that was donated to the Trust in 1977 by Ellen Preston in memory of her late husband.

The property is mostly wooded with both dry upland forest and flood plain thickets which lie along the Little River. Two hayfields, one mown yearly and one in early succession provide two more habitat types. The Preserve is managed primarily as wildlife habitat, and to provide protection for a significant watershed area. The hayfield keeps farming active on prime agricultural soils, another Trust goal.



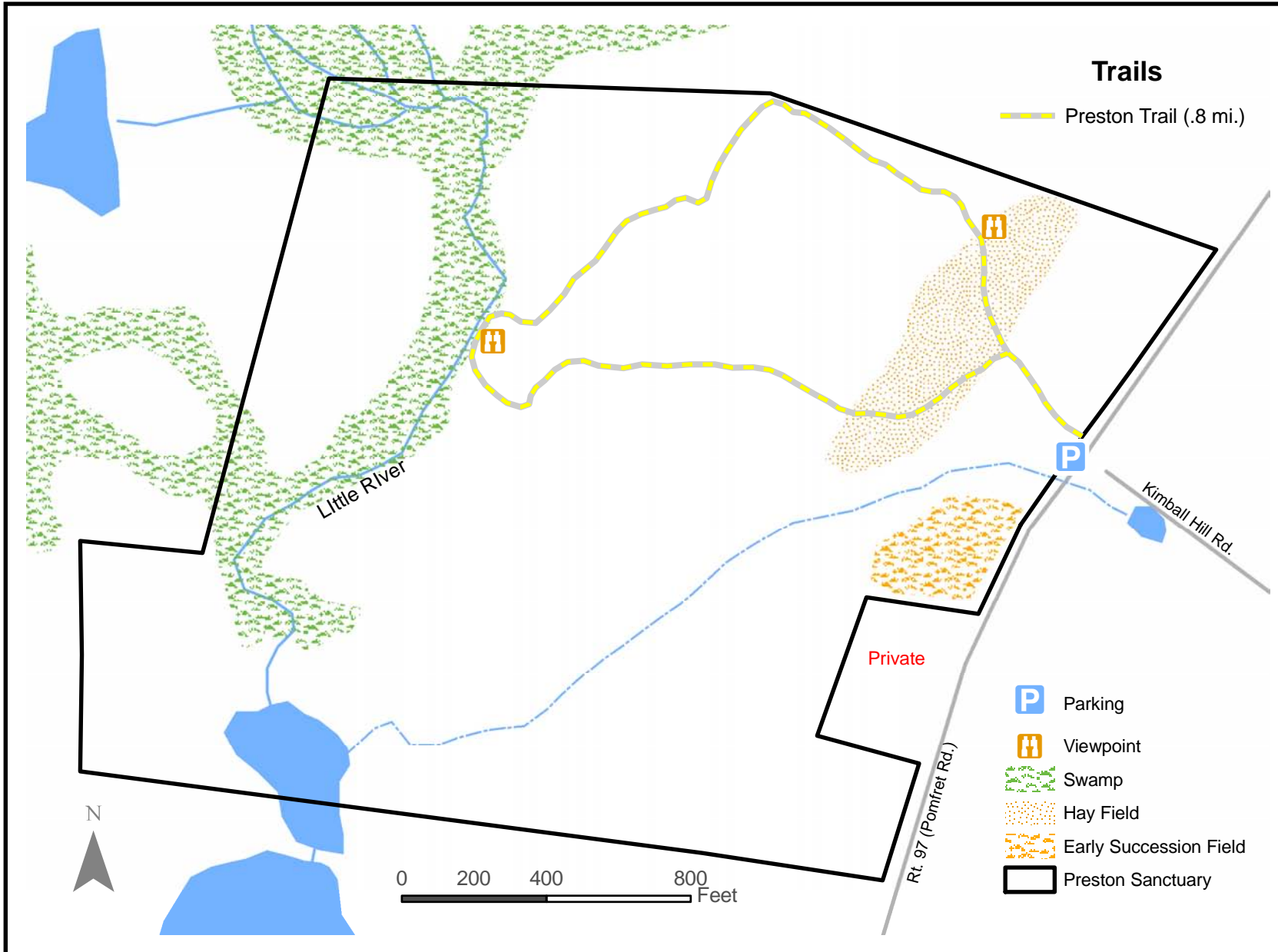

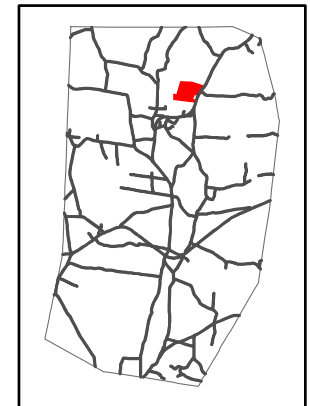

Directions: The preserve lies on the west (left) side of Rt. 97 about 4 mi. north of Rt. 6 in Hampton and about 3 mi. north of the center of town. A sign opposite Kimball Hill Rd. marks the entrance. Parking is on the grassy shoulder of Rt. 97.
