

Tobiassen Memorial Forest

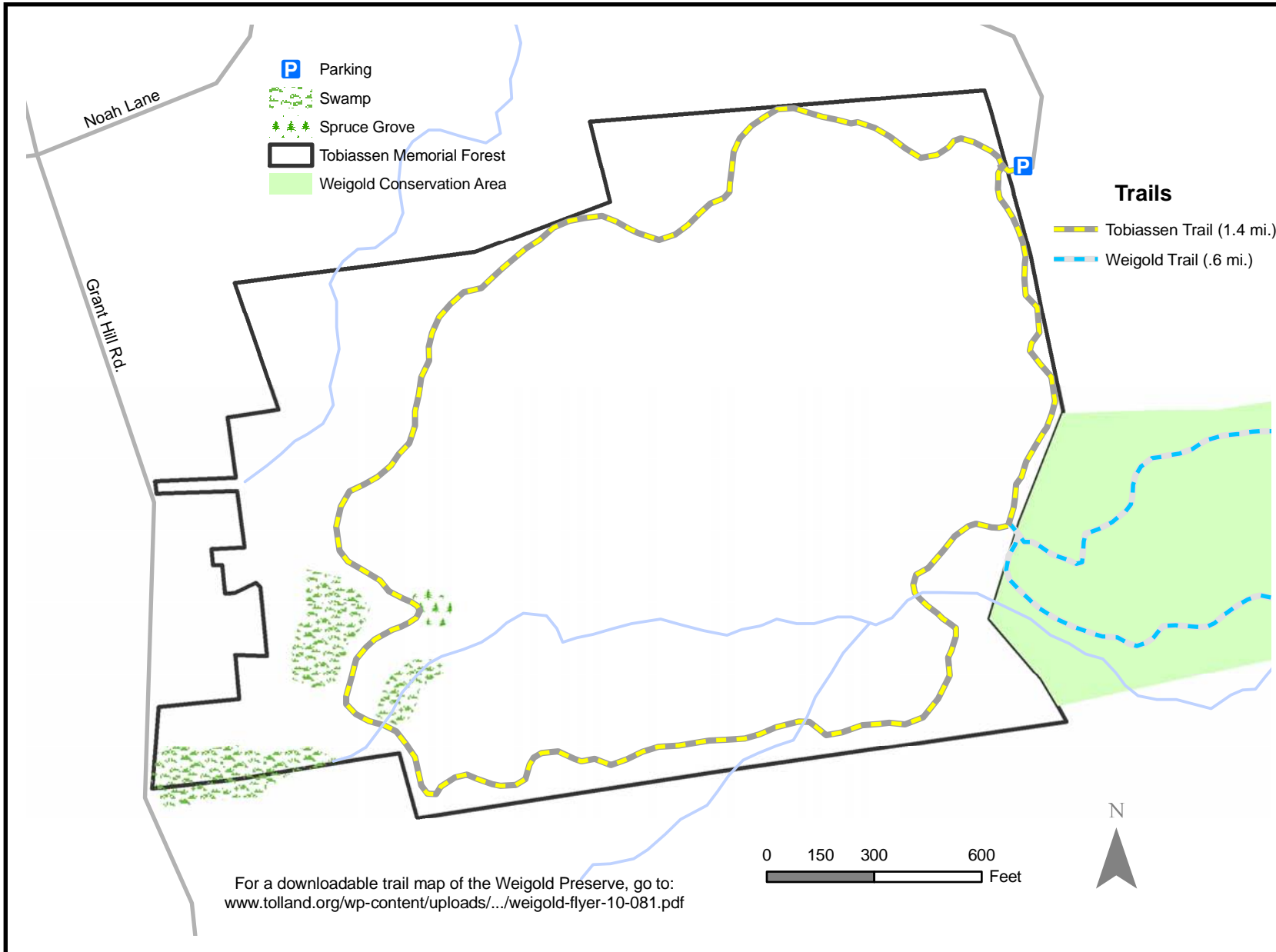

Doris and Al Tobiassen Memorial Forest was left to the Trust by Doris Tobiassen in 1991. It consists of 84 wooded acres that lie in the Meeting House Hill section of Tolland. This area was the original town center with houselots laid out along Grant Hill Road by settlers from Windsor. The property is covered with a mature oak-hickory forest, and gently slopes down from Grant Hill Road. A small stream lies along the southern boundary and drains across the adjoining Weigold Preserve belonging to the town of Tolland.

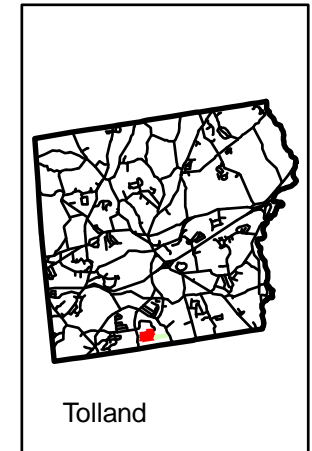

Directions: From the junction of Rt. 31 and Rt. 44 in Coventry, go north on Grant Hill Rd 2.8m to Noah Lane. Turn right on to Noah Lane and go .9m to its end. Park on the right side of the cul-de-sac where the trail begins. Weigold Access at 256 Weigold Rd.
